

HISTORY OF QUALITY MANAGEMENT AT KTU

- Upon the publication of the Regulation Governing Quality Assurance in Higher Education by CoHE, the KTU Quality Commission was established in 2015 and started its work.
- KTU voluntarily applied to the Higher Education Quality Board (YÖKAK) External Evaluation Process in 2016. It was among the first universities to pass the process.
- KTU was ranked among peer universities in terms of Integrated Quality Processes Practices by YÖKAK in 2018.
- Quality studies were given importance in the KTU 2019-2023 Strategic Plan, and targets were set to improve processes.
- As of 2019, Internal Unit Evaluations and Field Visits have started to be made by the KTU Quality Commission.
- At the end of 2019, the Directive for the KTU Quality Assurance System was accepted by the KTU Senate and entered into force to institutionalize quality studies.
- According to YÖKAK 2019 General Evaluation Report, KTU ranked first among state universities in terms of the number of accredited programs.
- In 2020, the KTU Student Quality Commission was established by taking a student representative from academic units.
- YÖKAK carried out a Monitoring program for our University. (08.10.2020)
- An application has been made for our University to be included in the Institutional Accreditation Program (KAP) run by YÖKAK. (20.04.2021)
- Preparation Guide to In-Unit Evaluation Report specific to the units (Faculty, Vocational School, School, Application and Research Centers and Departments) was prepared by the KTU Quality Commission. (16.07.2021)
- The application made by our University to be included in the Institutional Accreditation Program (KAP) by YÖKAK was approved. (19.08.2021)
